## Who should be referred?

If you have a concern about a student who you perceive to be threatening, harming, or disruptive, please let the Office of Student Care and Concern know via a Care Team Referral form.

This includes a student whose behavior or well-being is negatively impacting those around the student.

## What happens when a referral is submitted?

Referrals to the Office of Student Care and Concern are received and reviewed within one business day of submission. The referral source may or may not be contacted to provide any additional information not indicated in the referral.

## What is the Student Care Team?

The Student Care Team is a multidisciplinary team that meets regularly to evaluate behaviors by University students that are perceived to be threatening, harming, or disrupting to the student, to others, or to both. The Team then coordinates an appropriate response.

If you feel threatened or know someone who is in imminent danger, call 911. The Office of Student Care and Concern does not respond directly to emergencies.
